

Seedco Intermediary Model



Scenario: Jane Smith

Works Full-Time, Earns \$14,500/year, single mom, two kids

Traditional Approach

- Jane must visit 3 separate offices for SCHIP, heating and nutrition assistance.
- She misses appointments when her child gets sick.
- The offices don't communicate with each other and don't tell her that she's missing benefits.

Bottom Line: Jane is eligible for approx. \$15K in benefits and credits but misses out on many.


*Earn*Benefits Approach

- Jane meets with an *Earn*Benefits counselor at her son's childcare center.
- An eligibility scan informs her of all federal, state and local benefits she can receive.
- She gets application help and the *Earn*Benefits counselor follows up in one month.

Bottom line: Jane gets the help she needs and receives every benefit for which she's eligible.

Jane's Budget Gap

Single mother, 2 children,
working as a childcare provider, \$7.15/hour



*Earn*Benefits Model



- Getting a job is not enough: maintaining continuous employment is the key to family well being
- Families receiving benefits are 30% more likely to stay employed

Reasons for Uncollected Benefits

- A lack of Knowledge
- A series of real and perceived barriers to enrollment
- Stigma associated with public programs

Benefits matter, but many of those eligible do not access public and private supports.

➤ *EarnBenefits* uses state of the art technology and facilitated enrollment services to easily connect low-wage workers to multiple public and private benefits.

➤ Our approach promotes stability and economic advancement by increasing access to multiple benefits.



➤ The program is currently in use in seven states in the U.S.







Marketing and Outreach

- Educate low-income families and service providers about benefits that promote job stability, advancement, and security
 - www.earnbenefits.org – comprehensive, user-friendly information on eligibility guidelines and application processes
 - **Marketing Campaign** – provides low-wage workers with the information they need to make choices that improve their bottom line.



Eligibility Screening & Facilitated Access

- Centralize and streamline access to multiple benefits
 - Use technology to screen for multiple benefits and store personal profile and completed applications
 - Provides information on factors that contribute to ineligibility
 - Work with government agencies to facilitate access to benefits (e.g. online completion of applications, e-filing, data sharing)

Benefits Management

➤ Engage low-wage families over time and ensure that benefit access leads to steady work and economic security:

- Follow-up and ongoing screening
- Trouble shoot application problems
- Assistance with re-certification
- Innovate new benefits to meet needs of low-wage families
- Track outcomes

EarnBenefits Network

National Sites: NYC, Atlanta, Baltimore, Louisville, Memphis, Tulsa, Buffalo & Connecticut

Partners: Community groups, faith-based and social services organizations, One Stops, workforce development programs and legal services agencies.

Funding: Local and National foundations, state and local governments, statewide intermediaries, community action agencies and United Ways.

Government Partnerships: Linkage to state-supported benefits portals, streamlined food stamp, Children's Medicaid and SCHIP application submission protocols, and data sharing.



Seedco in Baltimore

Seedco's focus in Baltimore are in the following areas:

- Benefits Access
- Capacity Building

Benefits Access: *Earn*Benefits Baltimore

- October 2006: *Earn*Benefits in Baltimore was launched.
- Seedco originally partnered with four organizations to operate *Earn*Benefits. The program has grown significantly in the past 4 years.
- Local Steering Committee provides strategic guidance to the initiative.
 - 12 trained partners
 - Monthly performance data reports
 - Estimated value of benefits received is \$10.7 million



Capacity Building

- Seedco works closely with its partners to help build capacity.
- Focus on implementation strategies and integrating *EarnBenefits* in partner agencies' workflow in a seamless manner.
- Forum for partners to share best practices and lessons learned.



Partnerships

- Seedco is now expanding *EarnBenefits* into Baltimore County.
 - Community Assistance Network
 - Second Chance Baltimore – Jail Expansion Project
 - SNAP outreach in Baltimore County

- Partnerships with agencies that are focused on children and families.



EarnBenefits Impact

- 119,000 households screened
- Over 67,000 have verified receipt of at least 1 benefit
- Over \$105 million in benefits accessed

EarnBenefits participants have higher job retention rates and are less likely to return to welfare.



Policy Change

New York City HRA included benefits access as a post-placement milestone in multi-year WTW contract.

Food Supplement Program (formerly Food Stamps)

Do you need help stretching your food budget?



QUICK FACTS

What is it?

The Food Supplement Program is a federal program that gives families money to buy food. Families can get Food Stamps even if they make too much money to qualify for Temporary Cash Assistance (TCA).

What do you get?

An Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT) card, called the Independence Card, that you use like a credit card at your local grocery store to buy food. The amount of money you get each month depends on your household size and income.

How long do you get it?

You can get Food Stamps for one month to one year before recertifying. When it's time to recertify, you'll get a letter in the mail. You must respond to this letter or your benefits will end.



LOOK OUT

Do You Have An Emergency?

If you have an emergency and need help buying food now, you may qualify for 'expedited service.' Expedited service means that you can get Food Stamps no later than seven days after you apply (instead of waiting 30 days). If your monthly household income is less than \$150 and you have less than \$100 in resources, you may be eligible to receive expedited Food Stamps. If you think you are eligible, ask your caseworker to verify this when you go in to apply for the benefit.

Do I qualify for the Food Supplement Program?

You qualify for Food Stamps if you:

- Are a U.S. citizen or legal adult resident who has resided in the U.S. for at least 5 years, or legal immigrant children regardless of when they entered the U.S.
 - Make less than 130% of the Federal Poverty Level (Table 1)
- OR**
- Make less than 200% of the Federal Poverty Level if there are children under 18 years old in your household (Table 2)**

If you feel you've been wrongly denied Food Stamps, make an appointment at your local Family Investment Center to discuss your case, or request a Fair Hearing at 443-423-4381.

How do I apply for the Food Supplement Program?

You can apply for the Food Supplement Program at your local Family Investment Center ([DSS Office Locations](#)). You can apply for Public Assistance, Medical Assistance (Medicaid), and Purchase of Child Care (POC) at the same time you complete your application for Food Stamps.

After you submit your application, you or a member of your household will need to be interviewed by a Family Investment Center representative.

You'll find out if you qualify for Food Stamps within 30 days after you submit your application.



LOOK OUT

If your public assistance case was recently closed and you have children, you'll continue getting Food Stamps for three months. After these first three months, you must apply so that you can continue to get Food Stamps.

You must report changes to your household in a timely manner. If you receive extra Food Stamps because you have not reported the right information, you will have to pay back the extra amount.



WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

To apply for this benefit, you will need:

- Proof of Social Security number
- Proof of identification
- Proof of Residency
- Proof of citizenship or immigration status
- Proof of household's income
- Proof of household's resources
- Utility and medical bills
- Canceled checks for child care or bill for child care
- Proof of rental agreement or mortgage statement
- Court order or canceled check for child support

ABOUT SNAP

Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) provides you with money to buy food.

HOW TO APPLY FOR SNAP

Online via Maryland SAIL:

1. Your *EarnBenefits* (EB) counselor will help you complete an online application through *EarnBenefits* or the Maryland SAIL website.
2. If you apply via SAIL you will receive a call within 24-48 hours from a case manager at Department of Social Services who will conduct an interview with you over the phone. If they cannot reach you by phone, they will send you an appointment letter with the time and date of either a phone or in-person interview.

If you complete the application via *EarnBenefits* you will mail or return the application to your local Department of Social Services office. You will be contacted within seven days for an interview.
3. Once you have completed your interview, you will need to gather copies of the following documentation and either mail it in or take it to your local Family Investment Center. If you can, bring this documentation to your interview in order to save time in processing your application.
 - Identification for yourself and the people in your household
 - Pay stubs from employers (provide at least one month, or four weeks of income for weekly pay periods)
 - Proof of all other sources of income
 - Proof of Social Security Number (SSN) for yourself and the people in your household
 - Proof of residency
 - Proof of citizenship or immigration status for yourself and the people in your household



If you are applying for the Food Stamp Program you can complete all of the form and give it to us now. You may also fill in your name, address, sign this page and give it to us. You can then finish the rest of the application at home and bring or mail it back to the office. Your food stamp benefit is based on the date you sign this application and give it to the department of social services. You may get food stamps right away if you meet one of the following conditions:

- > Your household's monthly rent or mortgage and utilities are more than your household's income and resources.
- > Your household's gross monthly income is less than \$150, and your resources, such as bank accounts, are \$100 or less.
- > Your household is a migrant or seasonal farm worker household.

If you qualify to get Food Stamps right away, we will take action on your application within 7 days from the date you sign the form. You will not get expedited food stamp benefits, if eligible, until we get a completed application form.
